Directions to Trial: Take HWY 395 to Gardnerville. At the traffic signal at HWY 395 & Waterloo Lane turn Right onto Waterloo if coming from South, Left if coming from North. Street name turns into Toler, then Fish Spring Road. Go approx. 5 ½ miles to Windmill Road, turn Left on Windmill and go ¾ mile to ranch at the corner of Windmill & Shena Terrace. Turn Right on Shena to ranch entrance just past the 1st house on the right. Signs will be posted.

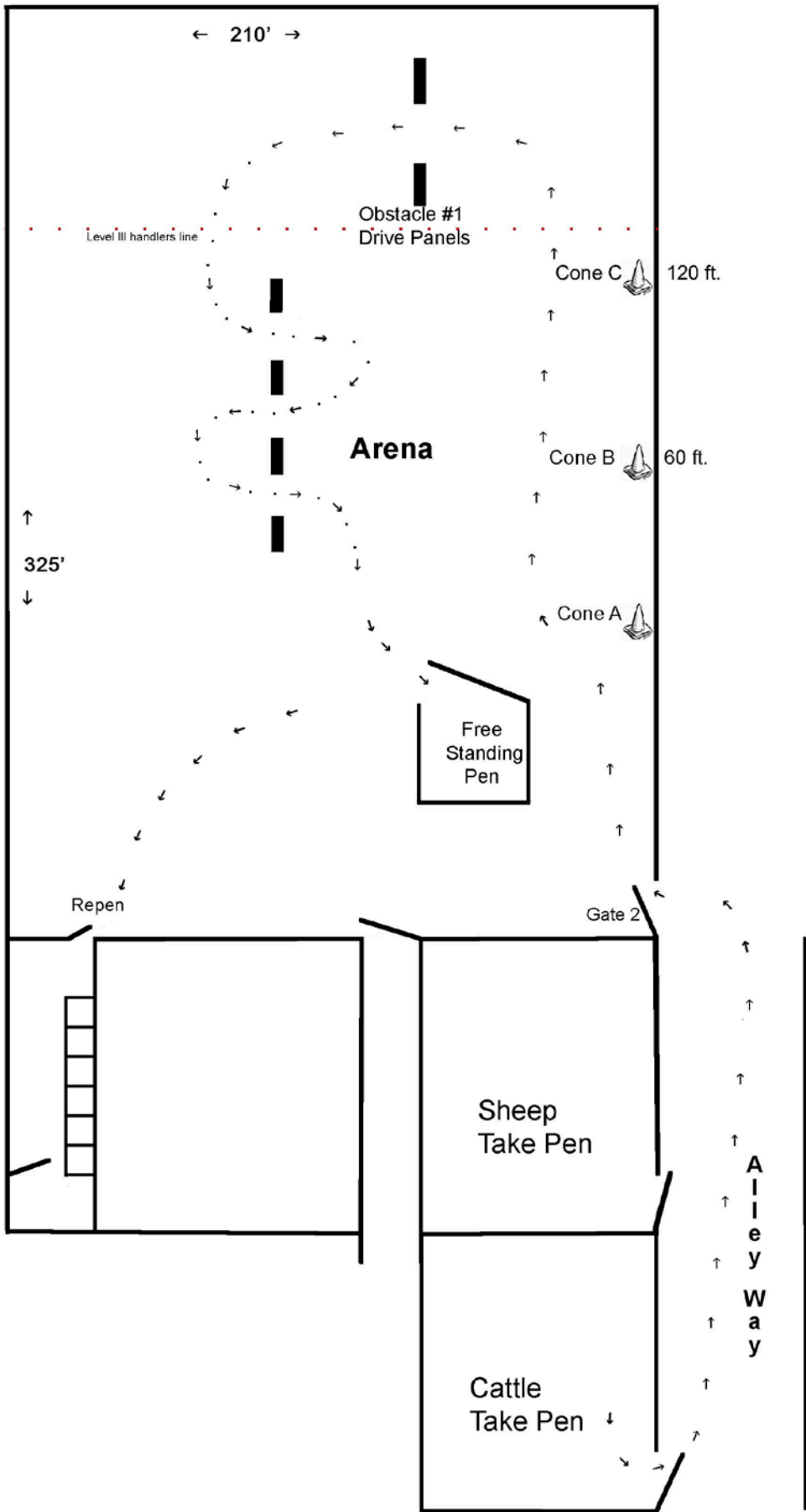

HRD AND RLF COURSE DIRECTIONS
FRIDAY & SATURDAY

1. Collect stock from take pen into alley way, closing gate behind.
 - Level III - Handlers may enter pen, may help dog if needed with point deductions, fetch or drive.
 - Level II – Handlers may go half way to stock, helping dog as needed, fetch or drive.
 - Level I – Handler may assist dog as needed, fetch or drive.

2. Take stock from alley way into Arena.
 - All levels may fetch or drive. Stock should remain under control.

3. Drive
 - Level III – Stock are taken to Cone **A**. Handler stays at Cone **A**, drive stock to Cone **C**, 120 ft.
 - Level II – Take stock to Cone **B**. Handler remains at Cone **B**, drive stock to Cone **C**, 60 ft.
 - Level I – Fetch or Drive to Cone **C**. Handler may accompany stock.

4. Drive Panels
 - Level III – Handlers move to Cone **C**, can move across the arena but cannot cross the handlers line which runs the width of the arena.
 - Level II – Handler may move to panels, remain at end of panel till all stock clear.
 - Level I – Handler may take any position, but may not enter obstacle.

5. Weave
 - All levels handlers may take any position at weave panels, may not enter obstacle.

6. Freestanding Pen. Pen all the stock, remove them and shut the gate.
 - Level III – Dog may enter pen to remove stock. Handler may assist but with scoring deductions.
 - Level II & I – Handler or dog (or both) may enter pen to remove stock.

7. Repen / Sort
 - For Cattle; sort off any 3 head.

 - For Sheep; there are 5 head marked.
 - Level III – Sort off 5 marked sheep.
 - Level II – Sort off 2 marked sheep and any other 3.
 - Level I – Sort off any 5 sheep.

- Tie breaks; 1. Take pen
2. Alley to arena.
