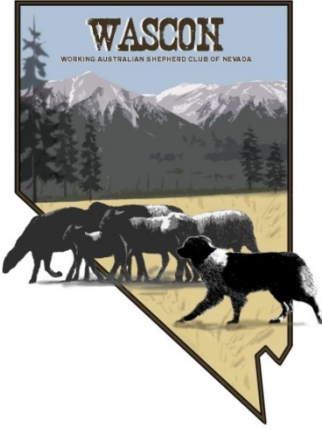

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

FROM SACRAMENTO: Approx. 15 miles past Woodfords, California on Hwy 88. watch for Centerville and Centerville Lane. Turn right on Centerville Lane. Stay on Centerville until it turns into Dresslerville Road (head left onto Dresslerville). Once on Dresslerville, go through 2 stop signs, then go 1/8th mile, watch for HERDING SIGNS and ¾ Circle H Ranch sign on the left.

FROM RENO: Take 395 S. to Gardnerville. Go through town. Turn right at stoplight at SHARKEY'S CASINO, this is State Route 756. Go 2 miles to Dresslerville Road. Turn left at the stop sign. Go 0.6 miles & through 1 stop sign watching for HERDING SIGNS and ¾ Circle H Ranch sign on the left.

FROM SOUTH (LA): Take Hwy 395 to Gardnerville. Turn left at the 7-11 onto Riverview Drive. Go 0.6 miles yielding to the right it becomes Dresslerville Road. Go another 0.8 miles through an 'S' curve. Watch for HERDING SIGNS and ¾ Circle H Ranch sign on the right.

In the event of Injury or Death of Livestock:

WASCON Handler Responsibility Clause:

In the event any stock is injured the dog handler is responsible for the loss of stock and stock use, cost of Veterinary treatment, if necessary, and any other expenses for treatment until stock has recovered.

The responsible party may NOT treat the animal or utilize any outside party without the stock provider's written permission.

In the event of death **or impending death of Livestock due to handler/dog during trial, handler will pay for Livestock at current market value. Payment to be made immediately.**

Handler is responsible for all costs of euthanizing Livestock.

Trial Hosts will not allow injured Livestock to be put down any way other than euthanasia by a locally licensed Veterinarian.

Disposal of dead Livestock is at the discretion of Livestock provider and Livestock remains the property of Livestock provider.

HANDLER/OWNER MUST READ & SIGN REVERSE SIDE OF THIS FORM
PARENT/GUARDIAN OF JUNIOR MUST SIGN AS WELL.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both handler and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- As used here, "ASCA®" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America®, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, and agents.
- Handler/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- Handler/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- Handler/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to: the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures (or lack thereof), electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people. Handler and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- Handler/owner releases ASCA®, the ASCA® affiliate/licensee club hosting the event (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and all site owner(s) harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event, or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, handler/ owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from, any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event; howsoever such injury, or death, may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may have been alleged to have been caused, by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.
- Should the entered dog injure stock, the owner will pay for veterinarian services. If the injury is severe, owner will pay the market value of the stock.
